




English Learners in LBUSD

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


EL Progress Monitoring: ELLevation

ELPAC 2021-22 to 2022-23





Annual Growth in Well Developed Student Group by Grade Grades 3-12






iReady: Diagnostic 2 Reading Placement



Dual Language Immersion


- At least 50% of instruction in Khmer w/ Khmer inst. materials
- Interest of 60 students per year, per grade
- Multiple Subject credential w/ Khmer Bilingual Authorization
- A minimum of 2 teachers a year

- Recruitment of local credentialed teachers
- Support for credentialed teachers to obtain Khmer bilingual authorization
- Partnership with CSUF: National Resource Center for Asian Languages
