Vision 2035

A year-long process in partnership with Prospect Studio to build a Vision and Strategic Plan.

Prospect Studio works with school districts and their communities to explore future trends, identify the future they want, and collaboratively design a path into that future.

We combine futures thinking with equity-centered design because

- We believe that those most impacted by change should have a role in designing that change
- Students and families know what they need
- To build a more equitable system we need to de-center power



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


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Timeline (August 2022 - Present)










Centered the voices of our students, staff, and community to build a collective Vision.

Equity design allowed us to build a vision based on the collective voice and come back to the community to check-in and iterate and fine-tune the Vision.









- 750 students at the Student Summit
- 3 Guiding Coalitions with a total of 103 members
- 82 community meetings, plus 2 Community Installation meetings
- 3 surveys
- 2 Podcast episodes featuring: Nader Twal (staff) and Arianna Perico (student from Avalon)

All sessions and surveys had Khmer and Spanish translated materials and community engagement sessions had interpreters. Childcare was provided at larger events
